Weight, length, head circumference
Lead & anemia screening

Vision screening
MMR, Varicella, Hepatitis A 

12 months


14 & 18 months


Weight, length, head circumference
14 months: Pentacel & PCV-20 
18 months: Hepatitis A

Weight, length, head circumference (2 years), blood pressure (3 years)
Vision screening
Lead & anemia screening

2 & 3 years


4, 5, & 6 years

Weight, height, blood pressure, pulse
Vision screening, hearing screen (5 years)
Lead & anemia screening (Worcester residents at 4 years)
4 or 5 years: MMR, Varicella, Quadracel 

Weight, height, blood pressure, pulse
Vision screening (8, 10, 12, 15 years)
9 years+: HPV
11 years: Tdap & Meningitis 

7-15 years

16-18 years

Weight, height, blood pressure (pulse oximeter and respirations for 18 years)
Vision screening before college (17-18 years)
16 years: Meningitis B & Meningitis ACYW 
17+ years: Meningitis B

Weight, height, blood pressure, pulse
21+ years: Tdap 

19+ years



= anticipated immunizations recommended at this age - subject to change pending patient health needs.
